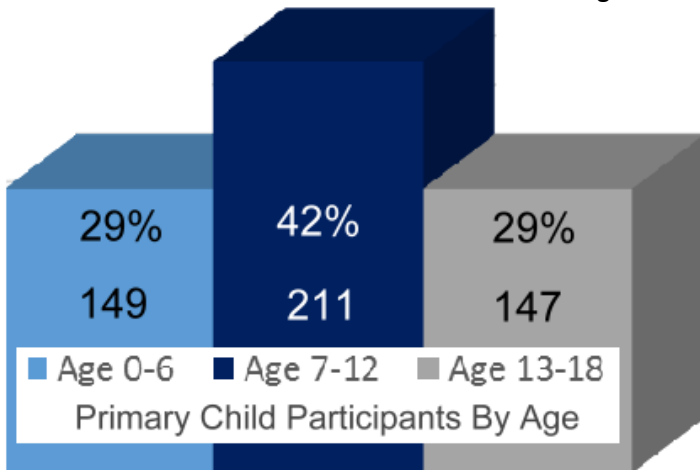
A Year in Review

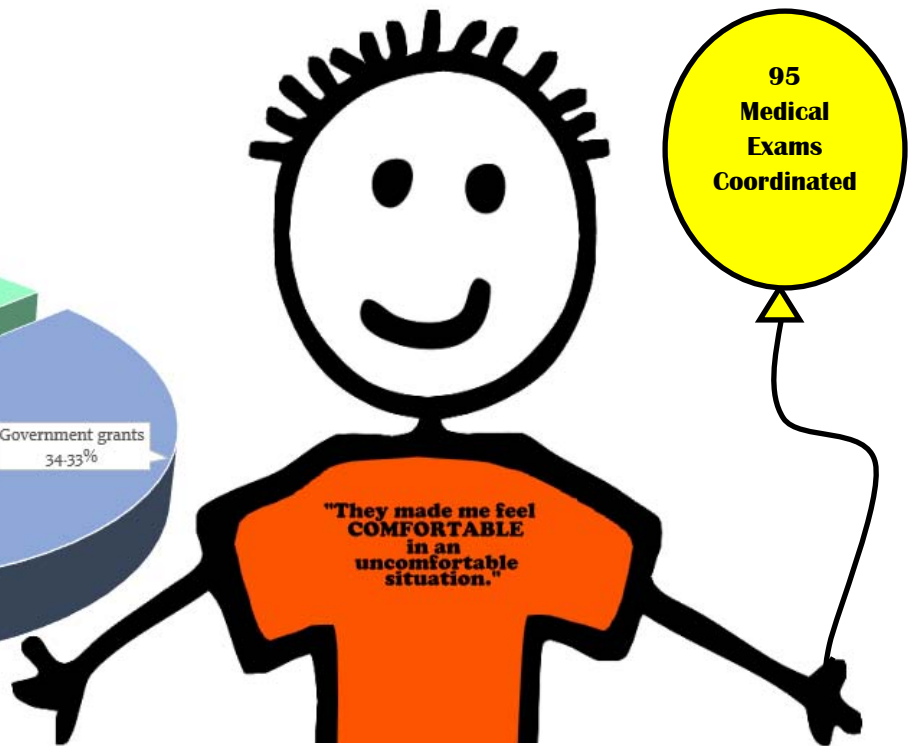
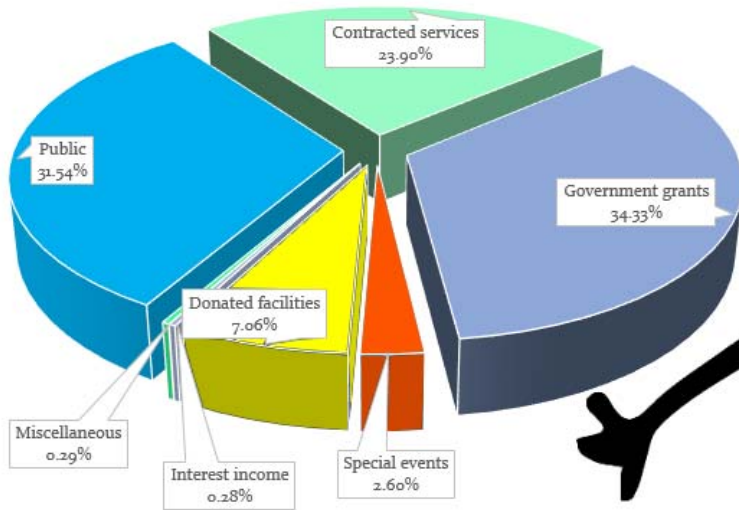
GRADE A:

Definition— of the highest grade, extremely good. By score, in the upper ninety-third percentile.

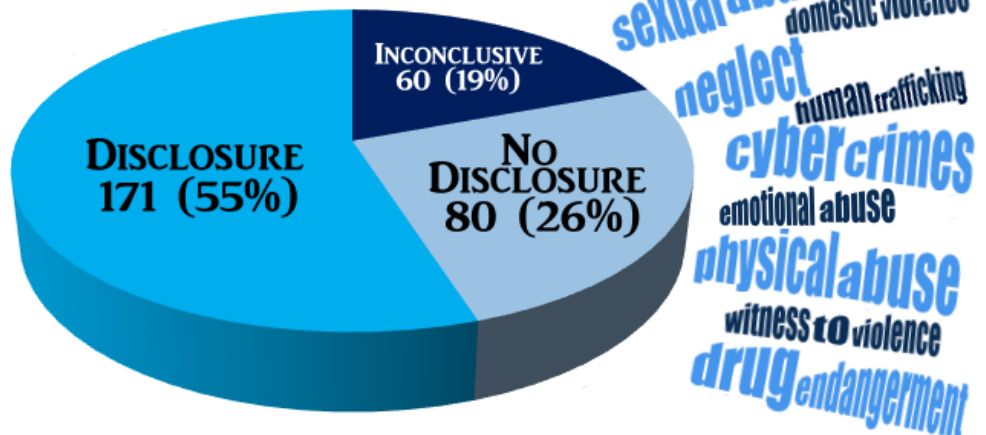
Upon completing their first visit, each family is surveyed on their experience. This info reflects excellence as noted
