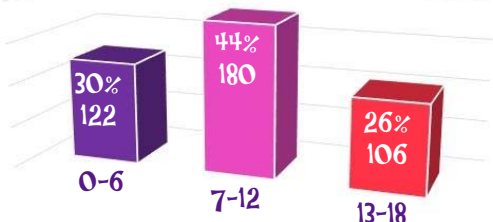

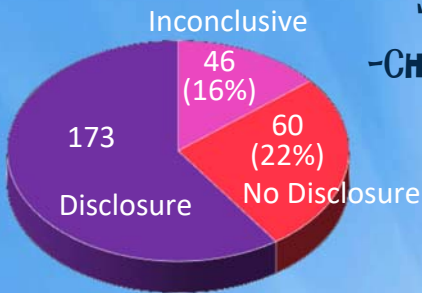

| FACT: | Harmony House served 121 children with reported developmental disabilities/delays  |
| FACT: | Though the highest categories of delays were ADD/ADHD and speech delays, Harmony House served 14 clients diagnosed with Autism/Autism Spectrum Disorders.  |
| FACT: | Recent studies show that 1 in 68 US children (1 in 42 boys and 1 in 189 girls) now have autism spectrum disorder. These children often find it difficult to interact or respond to social situations.  |
| FACT: | 99% of ALL children, including those with special needs, felt safe and comfortable at the center. Forensic interviewing is a non-leading, victim sensitive, neutral, and developmentally appropriate investigative process that helps minimize any potential trauma to the victim. Harmony House prides itself on being there for the child above all other reasons and factors. |

Primary Child Participants by age

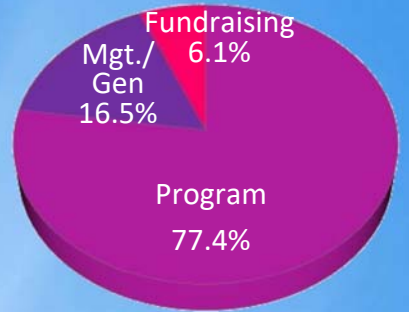

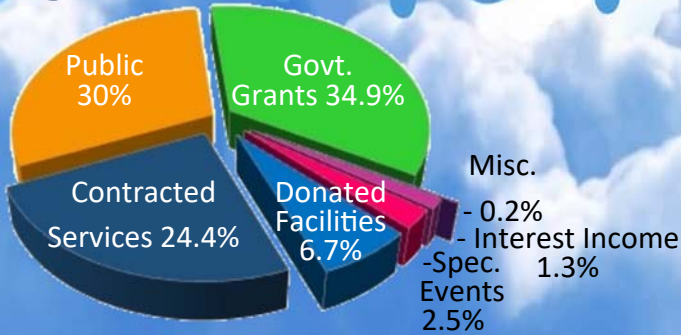
